- Are you registered?
  Find out who your Doctor is and where the surgery is.
- Put your Doctors Phone Number in your contact list on your mobile.
- Get to know your GP Surgery's services and who does what, you can discuss this with a Corner worker.
- Phone them. (You can use the Corner phones)
- Be clear and calm when calling for an appointment, there are pre-bookable appointments available in some surgeries, just ask.
- Ask about a double appointment if you have lots to discuss.

- Check out your GP Surgery's Website . (You can use Corner computers)
- Check out the www.docready.org site which helps you plan for your appointment.
- Ask a trusted friend or relative to provide support before and after your appointment.
- Make a list so you know what you want to say. (Example overleaf.)
- Sometimes a telephone appointment is all it takes, they can be with a GP or a Nurse, they may call back to talk to you.
- If your surgery has a Practice Nurse they can provide lots of services previously only provided by a Doctor, ask about it.

It may be helpful to fill this in before your appointment:
